LAS VEGAS – In partnership with Clark County, Lutheran Social Services of Nevada will be hosting an Easter egg hunt and resource fair. 16 local nonprofits will provide wrap around services including dental screenings, vision testing, energy assistance, SNAP benefits, SNAP Education, employment services, mentorship opportunities, and more. This will be a joyful experience that includes Easter baskets, educational resources, snacks, snow cones, beverages, goodie bags, an egg hunt, live music, crafts, games and more.

Admission and all services are free. Media is invited to attend.

Children who find golden eggs may turn them in to receive door prizes.

Last year's Easter Egg Hunt and Resource Fair served 390 children from 229 families, and we expect to serve more than 500 children this year. Anthem Blue Cross Blue Shield and Robert Stoffel Family Law Group are sponsoring the event.

LSSN is known for its diverse services for individuals of many demographics, including low-income, at-risk homelessness, homeless, families with or without children, youth, veterans, people with disabilities, and senior citizens. Comprehensive social services include DigiMart, an online food pantry; mobile food distribution events called Open Air Markets; nutrition education classes and live cooking demonstrations; senior supportive services including the Senior Meal Program; employment services; women's health resources; mainstream benefits applications; and other safety net services.

Although Lutheran-based, LSSN is open and inclusive in the services that they offer with an extensive nondiscrimination policy.

The mission of LSSN is to express the Love of Christ by Serving and Caring for People in Need. LSSN serves about 3500 people per month and over the last 27 years has served over a half a million individuals.
